School Office

If children are late, they must sign into the office and order their lunch. If going home for lunch, children should be collected from the office. Should you be in school during the school day you must report to the office before entering the school. The office is not attended on a Friday but staff do pick up answer machine messages regularly throughout the day.

Positive Reinforcement Policy

We implement a positive behaviour approach to discipline, using restorative approaches to manage conflict or misunderstandings in the playground. Well-established schemes reward good behaviour and include certificates, which are presented at assembly, Class Dojo points, lunchtime certificates and the Golden Wall/ Table. Our class teachers also operate his/her own class reinforcement scheme in class which is discussed and agreed with pupils at the start of each session.

Items to bring to school

We advise that children bring a school bag each day to carry their equipment and a home learning bag, which can be purchased at the school office, for homework, letters and books. Children will need to bring in a gym bag for PE which can be left on their peg in the cloakroom. Children are also encouraged to bring in a water bottle each day to use in class.
